Re: Water Restrictions

Dear Water User,

The trustees of the Greystoke Improvement District had an emergency meeting last night to discuss water restrictions for our system. As our area is experiencing a severe drought with no moisture in sight, we feel all of us must do our part to protect our system.

A few weeks back, a reminder was sent out regarding efficient water use; however, we are still seeing residents water against the recommendations set out in that email.

We are checking the well every second day at this point, and in two days, it dropped 10 inches. This is very concerning. If we were to experience a breach in our lines again, at this time, it could put our system in jeopardy.

Effective immediately, the GID is imposing water restrictions as follows:

Greystokes Road (Lawn irrigation only):

• Tuesday / Thursday / Saturday

Dion Road & Highway 33 (Lawn irrigation only):

Wednesday / Friday / Sunday

Irrigating can occur between:

- 4:00 am to 10:00 am
- 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm
- No watering between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm

There will be no watering on Mondays, so hopefully, this will give the system time to recover.

Exceptions:

 You can continue to water your vegetable gardens, hanging baskets, flowerpots, and domestic animals daily.

These restrictions will be in effect until further notice. We will keep everyone apprised of any changes.
